

Table 4: Cross-Sectional Estimates by College: Heterogeneity by Gender and Alternative College and Income Definitions

This table presents data analogous to that in Table 2 using a set of alternative college and income definitions, by child gender, and adjusting for regional cost of living differences when measuring incomes. We provide the same set of variables as in Table 2 for each specification (except for median parent incomes by child gender, which were unavailable for this release). We identify the specifications using the following suffixes after the variable names:

Suffix	Robustness Check
_coli	Alternative income definitions: adjust baseline measures of parental income and child income for regional cost-of-living differences (measured at the CZ level, based on residence in year when income is measured).
_m	Baseline definitions, male children only
_f	Baseline definitions, female children only
_agi	Alternative child income definition: measure children's income at the household level, including capital gains (Adjusted Gross Income)
_wagse_hh	Alternative child income definition: measure children's income as total household wage earnings (i.e., own plus spousal labor earnings)
_age20	Alternative college definition: assign students to the colleges based on the college they attended at age 20
_age28	Alternative college definition: assign students to the first college they attended before age 28
